### Finance Report 2024

May Revenues \$13,535 May Expenses \$21,669 May Deficit (\$8,134)

Total Annual Revenue \$147,369 <u>Total Annual Expenses \$249,569</u> **Total Annual Deficit (\$102,201)** 



We had 4 Sundays with two paydays in May. Our pledged, non-pledged and memorial offerings were much better for May. We had no Per Capita donations in May.

### This is the end of our fiscal year.

For the month, our actual income is about 11% below our budget and our expenses are 25% greater than what we had budgeted. Our total assets in the last month of our fiscal year are \$926,497 which is \$21,823 better than last month.

The market and some of the changes in our investments have helped; however, we will need to do some major repairs to our boiler system and our organ this summer. Our new Pastor, Joy Edeker, will be starting in July. We will budget for her compensation package and moving expenses in the new fiscal year.

A special thanks to all the Blessings from our past church saints, without their gifts we would not be in this stable position. Please consider helping to support the church's Christian Ministry programs in your pledges and donations. Your pledged and non-pledged offerings are critical for us to maintain sound fiscal stability.

It's a truly fine day today, a slight breeze to ruffle the flags in the neighborhood. Perfect to pull weeds... not the most exciting thing to be doing on a



gorgeous day, yet so necessary. The weeds are spreading quickly and need to be dealt with. As I dug and gently pulled the hair-like roots, it occurred to me that if I had spent as much time **"rooting out" scripture** all these years, I would be so much farther along the spiritual path that God has led me through.

He has nudged me all along to read His Word more, not just read books about His Word. Yes, the books have provided another way of looking at God's Word, to hear what others have discerned, and I have grown from that knowledge. Yet, today while weeding, He impressed me with the need to spend more time with Him, not just in my daily talks with Him, but listening for His voice, while reading His Holy Word. There is so much more to learn, and share.

In weeding today I took a look at, and thought about, the way **we describe weeds:** any plant that is planted where we don't want it to be. We replant the nice ones that we call flowers, and cast out the ones that we consider tiresome weeds, to be disposed of as quickly as possible. Then I looked at the gloves on my hands that protect me from all manner of things: sharp rocks, bugs, prickly weeds, dirt stains, to name a few. My mind took me to the people we see every day. Do we see weeds in our pathway, to be cast aside? Do we wear emotional gloves? What do we think we are protecting ourselves from? Or do we see the flowers in their spirit that God sees?

**God impressed on me today to be more like Jesus**. We are to show loving kindness in ways that may not have been apparent before. Let's all look more deeply into our own hearts and open our eyes, ears and mouths, to be open to God's leading, and His healing, by the sharing of His Words.

Let's support each other, as we enter into this next phase of our Christian life with our new pastor, Joy Edeker.
