We had 5 Sundays with three paydays in July. Our fiscal year began in June. We had several prepaid pledges that helped with the June numbers but for the most part, prepaid pledges have been received. We had no Per Capita donations in July.

So far this fiscal year, our actual income/expenses were on the positive side of our budget. Our asset total is \$966,719 which is \$11,334 higher than the previous month. This is good, since we had to sell some assets in July to support our expenses, but the market has been in our favor. Our total assets are (\$233,625) lower than the same period a year ago. The down turn in the market over the past year has hurt our asset value, plus we had to sell some assets over the last 12 months to cover expenses. We are adjusting our asset classes to meet the market swings.

Our expenses will be increasing as we are re-starting many of the programs that had been shuttered. Please consider helping to support these programs in your offerings.

Your pledges are critical for us to make a functional budget. Please pray about it and do your best to give to the church your anticipated pledge.


