

FINANCE REPORT 2025

March Revenues \$11,869 <u>March Expenses \$33,786</u> March Deficit (\$21,917)

Year to date Revenues \$119,345 Year to date Expenses \$273,310 Year to date Deficit (\$153,965)



We had 5 Sundays with two paydays in March. Our pledged & non-pledged offerings were better for March but we had 5 Sundays. We had one Per Capita donation in March, thank you, this really helps the church's finances.

This is the tenth month of our fiscal year. For the month, our actual income is about 14% below our budget and our expenses are 2% less than what we had budgeted. The yearly deficit is the challenge for us but getting better.

Our total assets in the tenth month are \$806,188 which is \$53,311 less than last month. The dip in our assets come from the widely swinging values in the market. This does not hurt us as long as we do not have to sell any of our assets.

A special thanks to all the Blessings from our past Church saints, without their gifts we would not be in this stable position.


