FINANCE 2025

We had 4 Sundays with 2 paydays in April. We had no Per Capita donations in March. Please consider helping the church with the Per Capita expense and please consider helping others with this expense, this can really help the church's finances.

This is the eleventh month of our fiscal year. For the month our actual income is about 16% below our budget and our expenses are 2% less than what we had budgeted. Our total assets in the eleventh month of our fiscal year are \$792,374, which is \$13,814 less than last month. Our total invested assets are lower by \$122,553 compared to April a year ago. The dip in our assets come from the widely swinging values in the market. We did need to sell a small amount of our assets to maintain our monthly expenses this month.

A special thanks to all the Blessings from our past Church Saints, without their gifts we would not be in this stable position.

Our Stewardship drive was in May. The Pledge cards are critical for us to plan the next year's budget so if you haven't sent a pledge card to the church, please give this some thought and prayer.


